### **Agenda No. 4: SWACHH BHARAT ABHIYAN – MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL IN BADAMIBAGH CANTONMENT**

Cantonment Board is mandated to provide sanitation services within the limits of the Cantonment and is responsible for collection, storage, transportation, processing and disposal of municipal solid wastes. The Board, presently, is collecting solid waste from the dustbins provided at various locations and is transporting it to the trenching ground situated at Lethpora - 34 km away from the Cantonment where it is disposed off by digging and filling trenches. As on date, 12 tippers (6 each from civil and military areas) of non-segregated solid waste are being sent to the trenching ground on daily basis.

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The municipal solid waste can be classified into biodegradable and non-biodegradable waste. The non-biodegradable waste can be further classified into recyclable and non-recyclable waste. The biodegradable waste should be converted to compost using suitable composting methods. The recyclable waste should be recycled and only non-recyclable waste should reach trenching ground. To achieve this, following scheme is proposed:

**1. Collection of Solid Waste** – It is proposed that-

- a) a survey for total number of houses, shops, schools, colleges, offices and other institutions within the Cantonment shall be conducted to arrive at number of units for which door-to-door garbage collection is to be implemented.
- b) a contractor shall be engaged for door-to-door garbage collection, collection of garbage from dustbins, transportation of collected garbage from collection points to Waste Processing Centre (WPC), segregation of waste at WPC.
- c) a sanitation fee at same or different rates may be charged from different types of waste generating institutions.

**2. Segregation of Solid Waste** – It is proposed that-

- a) the garbage shall be segregated into biodegradable, recyclable non-biodegradable and non-recyclable non-biodegradable wastes. The non-biodegradable waste shall be segregated to the lowest possible categories and shall be stored separately till their disposal through suitable methods.
- b) segregation shall be done at WPC through a contractor.
- c) the Board will take measures to motivate people to do segregation of their garbage at their homes, shops, schools, colleges, etc.

**3. Storage of Solid Waste** – It is proposed that-

- a) biodegradable and non-biodegradable waste shall be stored at WPC or at place identified for the purpose till it is processed and converted to manure or sent to trenching ground for its final disposal there.

**4. Transportation of Solid Waste** – It is proposed that-

- a) all the waste shall be transported to WPC for its segregation into bio and non-bio degradable waste using appropriate medium. Only non-biodegradable waste which can't be recycled or processed or put to any beneficial use due to unavailability of suitable means or any other reasons shall be moved to trenching ground.

**5. Processing of Solid Waste** – It is proposed that-

- a) the processing of waste shall be done at Waste Processing Center (WPC) to be constructed for the purpose.

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- b) the biodegradable waste after segregation shall be converted into manure using suitable composting method.
- c) recyclable non-biodegradable waste shall be stored and disposed off at regular intervals in a manner suitable for disposing off such waste.
- d) non-recyclable non-biodegradable waste that can't be put to any beneficial use or processed shall be moved to trenching ground for its proper disposal.

#### REQUIREMENTS – INFRASTRUCTURE AND OTHERS –

- 1. Land for construction of WPC
- 2. Contractor for door-to-door garbage collection and segregation
- 3. WPC with facilities for
  - a) Segregation of waste
  - b) Conversion of biodegradable waste into manure
  - c) Storage of recyclable non-biodegradable waste for its periodic disposal.
  - d) Movement of non-recyclable non-biodegradable waste to trenching ground.
- 4. Contractor for operation and maintenance of WPC, if required.

#### IMPLEMENTATION STEPS –

To implement this scheme, following steps are proposed-

- 1. Commencement of survey for implementing door-to-door garbage collection.
- 2. Identification of suitable land by the Board inside or outside Cantonment for construction of WPC.
- 3. Identification of a suitable method for composting biodegradable waste by the office of CEO after studying similar methods implemented by other government / private organisations.
- 4. Construction of WPC including procurement of tools and machinery.
- 5. Floating of tenders for door-to-door garbage collection and segregation.
- 6. Floating of tenders for hiring manpower for operation and maintenance of WPC on need basis.

The Board may consider and give its decision on the proposal.

#### **RESOLUTION NO. 4**

Considered and decided that a consultant for the project be engaged to prepare a Detailed Project Report ( DPR) to implement Municipal Solid Waste ( MSW) Rules. The waste collected by Cantonment Board from military ( except for door to door garbage collection) and civil areas shall be processed through the proposed project.

#### **Agenda No. 5: EMPANELMENT AS CANTONMENT BOARD LEGAL ADVISOR (CBLA)**

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The Board may consider application of Ms Gousia Jan, Advocate, for empanelment as Cantonment Board , Legal Advisor (CBLA) for pleading court cases on behalf of Cantonment Board, Badamibagh in Srinagar District Court. The payment to the advocate shall be made as per Govt. approved rates. At present the Ms Gousia Jan, is also pleading cases as Standing Counsel for District Floriculture Officer, Srinagar. The Board may approve empanelment of the advocate for 6 months i.e. upto 31 Dec, 2016, initially. The term may be extended further based on her performance.

The case file along with list of cases contested by the advocate in District and High Court is placed on the table.

**Agenda No. 6: PURCHASE OF 30 KVA/24 KW SILENT DIESEL GENERATOR ON DGS&D RATE CONTRACT FOR VOCATIONAL TRAINING INSTITUTE CANTT. BOARD PUBLIC SCHOOL**

The students enrolled in the Cantonment Board vocational training institute, Sonwar are facing problems due to sudden break-down of electricity on routine day to day basis while taking practical classes of ERP9 Tally Course and have requested to provide Diesel Generator.

To over-come the problem, line-man of Cantonment Board, Badamibagh was detailed to estimate the load of Vocational Training Institute as well as Cantt. Board Public School (CBPS) separately. As per report submitted by Line-man at least 30 KVA capacity Diesel Generator will be suitable for the said purpose for both Vocational Training Institute as well as Cantt. Board Public School (CBPS).

In this regard, proforma bill amounting to Rs. 3,52,938/- (including VAT etc.) was obtained from Sanjay Diesels (Authorized GOEMs – Mahindra & Mahindra D.G Sets, 41-A, Industrial Extension Area, Kathua, J&K) to purchase on DGS&D rate contract. The specification of gen set is as under:
